


SPECIALLY PREPARED ITINERARY FOR 2N KATRA 2N AMRITSAR





KATRA:

Katra or Katra Vaishno Devi, as it is popularly known, is a small town in Reasi district in the state of Jammu and Kashmir, India, situated in the foothills of the Trikuta Mountains, where the holy shrine of Vaishno Devi is located. It is located 42 km from the city of Jammu.

AMRITSAR:

Amritsar is a city in the northwestern Indian state of Punjab, 28 kilometers from the border with Pakistan. At the center of its walled old town, the gilded Golden Temple (Harmandir Sahib) is the holiest gurdwara (religious complex) of the Sikh religion. It's at the end of a causeway, surrounded by the sacred Amrit Sarovar tank (lake), where pilgrims bathe.



Day 1: Report at Biju Patnaik International Airport Bhubaneswar

After Breakfast proceed to Golden Temple which is one of the most important pilgrimage destinations in India. Later move to Jalianwallah Bagh a historical monument that tells the sad story of mass killing during the independence movement in India, is must visit in Amritsar.
